In his new book *Virtual Worlds and the Values of the Digital Future*, published in 2025 as a joint release by Alma Mater Europaea University Press and Annales ZRS, Dr Gašper Pirc explores the effects of digitalization and the advent of advanced artificial intelligence on contemporary society. The author engages with current technological trends and examines them through a critical and ethical lens, addressing issues such as online law, moral standards in digital environments, digital violence, AI ethics, the status of digital agents, and the internal structures of online and virtual worlds.

The monograph places particular emphasis on research into the metaverse, virtual reality, and the legal and ethical dimensions of artificial intelligence - topics that are becoming increasingly important not only in specialized academic literature but also in broader public debate.
